**About Us:** This position is located in the Chemical, Biological, Nuclear and High Yield Explosives (CBRNE) Defense Office of the Anti-terrorism Force Protection (ATFP) Program Management Division under the Director, Base Development, Naval Facilities Engineering Command (NAVFAC Headquarters), Washington, DC. The NAVFAC CBRNE office serves as the acquisition portal for CBRNE supporting requirements for Naval Shore Installations, Naval Construction Force and Naval Beach Groups. The office assists in developing concepts, requirements, programs and objectives pertinent to CBRNE readiness responsibilities for Naval Shore Installations, Naval Construction Force (NCF), and Naval beach Group (NBG).

**About the Job:** Incumbent serves as the NAVAFC CBRNE Office subject matter expert for CBRNE technology, Research Development Test and Evaluation (RDT&E), and regulatory compliance for consequence management to terrorist use of Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD). Specializes in CBRNE technology, RDT&E and regulatory compliance issues and provides coordination between NAVFAC and OPNAV staff. Conducts research and analysis to justify development of CBRNE system requirements. Develops or assists in the development of service specific and joint service documentation which establishes needs and requirements through issuance of Initial Capability Documents (ICD) and Capability Development Documents (CDD). Serves as NAVFACHQ coordinator for CBRNE related RDT&E issues. Provides support to Joint Program Manager Guardian (JPMG) Installation Protection Program (IPP) for Navy Shore installation CBRNE including site survey support and coordination with JPMG Lead System Integrator (LSI) for Government off the Shelf (GOTS) and Commercial off the Shelf (COTS) material and equipment. Works on behalf of CNI to coordinate environmental and occupational safety and health compliance issues for Navy CBRNE programs. Reviews Navy CBRNE training course curricula for consistency with current CBRNE material and equipment fielding plans. Provides coordination for shore installation CBRNE issues with the Emergency Medical Services Working Group, BUMED Emergency Management Working Group, Interagency Safety Working Group and Technical Support Working Group.
